



Getting to the Australian Technology Park (ATP)

The ATP is adjacent to Redfern railway station. If you're staying in the city, take the train to Redfern (one stop from Central, two stops from Town Hall). Return tickets are the most economical. When you get to Redfern, exit via platform 10 where you'll see a sign for the ATP. Walk past the Water Tower apartment block and follow the walkway through to the Australian Technology Park. It's a 5 minute walk from the station to Bay 4 at the ATP, and 3 minutes more to Bay 15. Here's a map of the ATP.



Taxis from the city will cost between \$10 and \$15 each way, depending on the time of day. There is also paid parking at the available at the ATP (\$15 per day).

Tutorials and Workshops – Tuesday April 18th

Main Conference – 19th-21st April

ASWEC 2006 registration opens at 8am in Bay 4 of the ATP on Wednesday 19th. The conference starts at 8.45am in the main auditorium in Bay 4.

Lunch, morning and afternoon tea/coffee are provided each day of the main conference.

Conference Exhibition

The conference will feature an exhibition area with stands representing each of the conference sponsors. Sponsors will be demonstrating new technologies and tools, so this is a great opportunity to find out about the state-of-the-art in software development technology.

Internet Access

We will feature a conference special fast wireless hotspot, at a mere \$10 a day (or \$20 for 3 days). The hotspot will cover the conference exhibition area in Bay 4.

Welcome Reception – Wednesday evening

The ASWEC welcome reception will be held amongst the conference exhibitors in Bay 4 from 5.30-6.30 on Wednesday 19th April.

Conference Dinner – Thursday night

The conference dinner will be held at Sugaroom restaurant, 1 Harris St, Pyrmont. The restaurant is located at the end of Harris St, next to the harbour. The best way to get to the restaurant is to take the tram from Central Station or Darling Harbour, and get off at the John St station (immediately after the Star City Casino stop). Exit John St station, turn left down the hill and walk around 150m to the end of Harris St. The restaurant is on the left by the waterfront – if you get wet, you've gone too far :-}. You will need a Conference Dinner Ticket, which will be issued when you register (full conference registrations only). Additional tickets are available at \$100.
